Glue (liquid; not glue stick)

Set of markers

6" ruler

Sketchpad (2<sup>nd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup>)



## **JUNIOR HIGH**

Watercolor Set

Two sharpened pencils or mechanical pencils

Small sharpener

Scissors

Eraser

Glue (liquid; not glue stick)

Set of markers

6" ruler

Sketchpad

**NOTE:** Sketchpads that are spiral bound tend to be sturdier than the ones that are bound by a glue strip. Sketchpads should not be larger than 9" x 12".
